Tradition, culture, history, architecture, modernity, gastronomy, wine and hospitality are some of Porto's unique, authentic and inspiring atributes.









Annually, the Port of Leixões receives around 80,000 passengers on cruise ships, coming from all over the world.














Accomodation


With 194 accommodation units, of which 47 are suites.


With a variety of beverages, carefully selected where the national wines stand out.

It is open from May to September.















Events

The events are part of the existing ecosystem where food waste, paper and plastic consumption are a primary concern.




















SPA - Flúmen Wellness Center

The space also has a dynamic Fitness Center, with a fully equipped gym and an elegant Pilates studio.












Open 24h, our fitness center offers a space dedicated to physical exercise and the practice of pilates.

Characterized by its amplitude, variety of equipment and a totally equiped pilates room, it allows a bigger diversity when exercising the body.







With 96 parking spots available, the park is adapted for people with reduced mobility and equipped for charging electric cars.

This space can also be transformed and adapted in order to host events.






All our rooms and corridors are equipped with presence detection technology to turn off the power.

We have 8 charging stations for electric cars in our garage.






We follow the "Meet with Purpose" program
