
Biographical Note





André M. Carvalho is Assistant Professor of Industrial Engineering at NOVA School of Science and Technology, NOVA University Lisbon, Portugal.

André holds a PhD (2020) in Engineering Design and Advanced Manufacturing from the University of Minho/MIT Portugal Program consortium. Between February 2018 and February 2019, he was a Visiting Student Researcher at the Sociotechnical Systems Research Center at MIT and remained as an MIT Portugal affiliate researcher until graduation in 2020. During his time in Boston, he was also Visiting Scholar at Northeastern University (March - September 2019). From January to December 2020, he was a postdoctoral researcher at the Technical University of Denmark.
